About the Position

The holders of the positions will devote most of their time, at least 70 percent, to their own research. Besides research, the positions also involve some obligations to contribute to teaching, supervising of graduate students and administration. The position is a three year stipend (post-doc), with a possible extension for an additional three years (assistant professor).

Applicants must have a Ph.D. in economics received after January 1, 2016 but preferably no later than September 2019.
